3. Basic Operations

3.1 Set Top Box Power On and Standby

3.1.1 Power On

1. Press < Power> key. The first channel will be automatically tuned.




2. If any favourite channel has been setup, the favourite channel will be automatically tuned.



3.1.2 Standby

- 1. If you press <Power> key while watching the TV, your Set Top Box goes to standby mode.
- 2. Pressing <Power> key again will take you back to previous screen from where it went to standby mode.



3.2 Tuning to Channels

3.2.1 RCU <CH+/-> keys


